Monthly water consumption and a \$100.00 rental charge is due on the 30th of each month. Nonpayment of water consumption may result in an assessment of late payment and/or retainage of all or part of deposits. Upon return of the rented equipment, your account will be verified and a refund will be processed.

CONDITIONS OF USE

- 1. Meter rentals are issued for job specific purposes only.
- 2. Responsibility for theft or any/all damage to District or private property resulting from hydrant use shall be the sole responsibility of permit holder. The permit holder shall be liable for any/all repairs and replacement costs.
- 3. Upon receipt of \$1,500.00 refundable security deposit and a one-time non-refundable permit fee of \$150.00, the District will furnish a hydrant meter for the permit holder's use at the rate of \$6.00 each calendar day. In addition, the minimum charge for the water used will be the current HCF usage rate set forth by the District.
- 4. The District can provide a Chapman valve for the permit holder's use for an additional monthly fee of \$50.00.
- 5. Locations and times of drawing water will be at the discretion of the District and all receiving vessels must be equipped with **approved backflow prevention**.
- 6. Payment shall be paid **in advance** of rental with check, cashier check, or money order.
- 7. Immediately report all emergencies to the District office at (503) 635-6041.
- 8. Obtain water **only** from designated hydrant listed on permit within the authorized period of time.
- 9. Hydrant shall be operated in a fully open position at all times and an approved hydrant wrench will be used to operate the fire hydrant. **At no time shall a pipe wrench be used**.
